Job Overview & General Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will be part of our Emissions Testing team, performing field testing at our client's industrial facilities in Western Canada. Responsibilities for this position include:

- Field work, which includes such things as travelling to worksites, setting up equipment, performing stack surveys, and assisting the team in ensuring methods, processes, and procedures are correctly followed.
- Driving a provided company vehicle, sometimes pulling a trailer, to various industrial sites throughout Western Canada, often for several days to a couple weeks at a time. While most work weeks will be Monday-Friday, project work will sometimes require weekend hours.



- Performing equipment calibrations and repairs as per prescribed methods and procedures. Will be responsible for maintaining emissions testing equipment and supplies, ensuring they are in good working order, clean and organized.
- Ensuring office, shop, and bays are continually maintained, clean and organized.
- Participating in and compliance with company safety program, including safety meetings, inspections, policies, and procedures.
- Inspecting ETG Vehicles and ensuring they are clean and in good working order.
- Maintaining a positive, professional attitude with fellow co-workers and clients.

What We Are Looking For In Candidates:

- Minimum of a valid Class 5 driver's license, with an acceptable five-year drivers abstract. Experience towing a trailer is an asset.
- Willingness and flexibility to travel up to several weeks per month throughout Western Canada, sometimes with short notice or with changes to schedules.
- Mechanically inclined, resourceful, and enjoys problem solving. Experience with farming, construction, industrial, mechanical, and/or field sampling work is not required, but will be considered an asset.
- Ability to work at elevated heights as sampling platforms can range from 50-300 ft.
- Ability to perform physical tasks which include:
 - Climbing ladders and/or stairs.
 - Routinely lifting/carrying equipment up to 50 pounds (both by hand and rope), periodic lifting and carrying equipment up to 70 pounds.
 - Consistent standing, walking, bending, crouching.
 - Able to be fit tested for, and wear, respiratory protection gear.
- Willingness to work outdoors in various weather conditions.
- Must complete pre-employment drug testing and meet ETG's Drug & Alcohol policy and program.
- A team player with a positive attitude who not only enjoys working as part of a project team but is also able to work individually on tasks.
- Strong attention to detail.
